CHAPTER I

INTRODUCTION

A. Background of Study

Language have important role in our life. People use language to communicate with one another constitutes a society. Language is a system of symbols through which people communicate. The symbol may be spoken, written, or signed with the hand. ¹ We can use language to express thoughts or feelings

Language is a system for the expression of meaning. Its primary function is for interaction and communication.² As its primary function is for communicate, this is human's duty to learn and understand language since there are many kinds of languages. That verse shows us that Allah deliberately create human differently to know each other using knowledge they have. People are unique, also with language. The language we speak or write is governed by number of rules, styles and constraints differently according to the place and inhabitants' agreement.

Human, community and language are very closely related.⁴ It because human are social creatures which they cannot live alone and need another. Human are social beings that seem driven to communicate. Deaf people develop the ability to communicate with gestures. And hearing people use sounds.

To most people, mastering the art of speaking is the single most important aspect of learning a second of foreign language, and success is measured in terms of ability to carry out a conversation in the language. There are some reasons why people are rather use sound than written language. Firstly, when people are using sound to express their idea, their hands are free for other task, and thus they can talk while the work. On the other hand, human use sound to communicate because using sound means changing the way people breathe and eat (Akmajian, Demers, et. al 1979).

Speaking is said as a part of the language ability in productive skill related to aural and oral medium that students need to acquire. Speaking proficiency becomes a primary intention for numerous language learner study English that need to be developed, because speaking is used in many different purposes. In several situations, we use speaking to make social contact with others, to adjust relationship, to express or give ideas. We may use speaking to describe

On the other hand, sound also makes one of the greatest distortions of the breathing rate occurs during speech. Breath is down rapidly and let out over a much longer period than during normal breathing.

From those all reasons, speaking is one of four language skills that needed in human life. It is a direct and easy way to send idea or feeling. Vice versa, speaking is one of students' redoubtable skills. Mostly students think that speaking is a hard skill that they need to reach. One problem in speaking appears because students think that speaking is hard, moreover, English is not their mother tongue.

Another problem in speaking appear because firstly, student (speaker) does not have full command of the target linguistic knowledge and acceptable or unintelligible form (unacceptable or unintelligible in terms of phonology, grammar or lexical). Secondly is student's knowledge of language. The necessary background knowledge (content, propositions) is not shared by the speaker and the hearer, and they bring a different set of expectation to the spoken interaction. The objective of the speaker is to be understood and for the message to be properly interpreted by the hears.⁸

To solve students' problem, they need to learn about speaking. It is a big duty for teacher to give an effective method in teaching speaking, because speaking has increasingly emerged as a special area in language pedagogy. One of basic problem in foreign language teaching is how to prepare learners to be able to use the language. So that the succession depends on how does teacher prepare appropriate method for students. Teacher should bring out the

method that makes students comfort and enjoy in speaking class. The method should build students' bravery, and students' interest in speaking.

In hundreds of studies, cooperative learning has been associated with gains in such variables as achievement, interpersonal skills, and attitudes toward school, self, and others. Beyond these overall gains, research also suggests that cooperative learning may lead to gain in thinking skills (Johnson & Johnson, 1990; Qin, Johnson, & Johnson, 1995). Therefore, as a classroom organization and instructional method, cooperative learning merits serious consideration for use in thinking classrooms. Indeed, several thinking skills programme, such as Dimensions of learning (Marzano, 1992).

In cooperative learning, there are some techniques that used. One of them is Bamboo dancing technique. Bamboo dancing technique gives a alternative technique for students to stimulates them to speak up when the teacher ask them about the material.

Bamboo dancing technique gives students opportunity to speak more in front of class. So the researcher chooses the title: "THE USE OF BAMBOO DANCING TECHNIQUE TO IMPROVE STUDENTS' SPEAKING SKILL (A Classroom Action Research at The 8th Grade Students of SMP Nurul Islam Semarang in The Academic Year of 2014/2015)"

B. Definition of Key Terms

1. Improving

2. Speaking Skill

Speaking is making use of language in ordinary voice; uttering words; knowing and being able to use a language; expressing oneself in words; making a speech or conversation. Speaking skill is someone's ability to convey messages and idea in his mind. Speaking is one of productive skills besides writing, which requires direct response, spontaneity and automaticity.

3. Bamboo dancing Technique

Technique is an important tool in classroom activity. Teachers need technique in conveying the subject in order to make students interest to the lesson. Technique is used by the teacher in order to convey material and make students enjoy in receiving the material. In this research, the technique which is used is Bamboo dancing technique. Bamboo dancing technique is a branch of cooperative learning.

Bamboo Dancing Method is a method of learning where teachers divide students into two large groups. Suprijono, introduced that learning model is usually preceded by dividing the class into several groups ¹². If in class composed of 40 students, the teachers split into two groups, each group content of 20 students. Each group has two different tasks; each group is further divided into two parts each of 10 students. The teacher asks the students to discuss different topics that will be studied. After discussion, 20 people from each major group that stood in a row following the line, they are shifted clockwise.

This technique not only asks students to convey speaking skill, but asks them to work cooperatively with their friends. Merges students' different opinion, and trains students to appreciate different opinion that arises from the topic.
