A. Standart of Competence

6. Writing

Expressing meaning in short functional text and write a simple essay in the form of a recount, narrative, and procedure in the context of daily life.

B. Basic Competence

Expressing meaning rhetoric and steps accurately, fluently and acceptable by using a variety of written language in the context of everyday life in text form: recount, narrative, and procedure.

C. Indicators

1. Students are able to comprehend the parts of speech such as adjective and verb (past tense).

2. Students are able to identify the social function, generic structure and language feature of recount text.
3. Students are able to use the simple past tense.
4. Students are able to compose a recount text.

D. Learning Aim

By the end of lesson through three-phase technique, students will have been able to respond the social function, generic structure and language feature of recount text; and make the written of recount text well.

E. Teaching Materials

Recount Text

Recount is a kind of text which retells events, activities, or experiences in the past.

1. Social function
To retell the event for the purpose of informing or entertaining.
2. Generic Structure
 - Orientation
Provides the setting and introduce participants
 - Events
Tell what happened, in what sequence
 - Re-orientation
Optional-closure of event
3. Language Feature
 - Focus on the individual participant
Example: I, my, group, etc.
 - Use of past tense
Example: we went to beach, I was happy, etc.
 - Use of material (action) processes
Example: went, slept, run, brought, etc.
 - Using conjunctions
Example: and, but, then, after that, etc.

- Using adverbs and adverbial phrase
Example: yesterday, at my house, slowly, etc.
4. Example of recount text:

Fantastic Holiday at Yogyakarta

Last week, I went to Yogyakarta with my family. My father drove the car. My mother sat beside him. My sister and I sat in the back seats.

We woke up early in the morning. My father prepared the car in the garage while mother was preparing food for breakfast and some snacks for us. My sister and I packed some clothes. After everything got ready and we had our breakfast, we left the house at six o'clock.

It was about nine A.M. We arrived at Yogyakarta. First of all we visited our uncle. We stayed there for an hour. Then we went to Parangtritis beach. We got there at eleven o'clock. There were a lot of tourists because it was holiday. I saw many foreign visitors too. My parents watched us playing with sand in the beach. We did not swim and take a bath since the wave was rough. After having lunch, we went on our picnic to the museum and Malioboro shopping centre.

We drove back to Semarang at 7 o'clock and arrived home at ten. We were tired but happy.
