CHAPTER I INTRODUCTION

A. Background

Education is a conscious and deliberate effort to create an atmosphere of active learning that learners are actively developing their potential to have spiritual strength of religious, self-control, personality, intelligence, noble morality, skills, community, nation and state.¹

Education is one of an important thing in our lives, it means that every person in Indonesia has a right to get education. affected by the geographical factor or economic condition in the $\operatorname{country.}^6$

A conducive environment is necessary for a good academic performance of a child.⁷ Low home environment quality is significantly of poor attainment. When the family atmosphere is very crowded, the child may not be able to learn well. The member of the family always watches TV/radio with a loud voice in the time of study. Children will always be distracted, so it makes the children difficult to learn. Likewise, the home atmosphere is always tense and a lot of bickering among family members.⁸ Children will fill like in the hell and they will go out with other friends who spent their time playing, so it is possible that their performance at school will decrease easily.

In Indonesia, most of parents' profession in the village are farmers, have low-education and low-income. Especially in
