
### CHAPTER III

# **B.** The Biography of Ron Clark

He has written three books concerning on education, that is: The Essential 55, The Excellent 11 and a must read book for teacher and parent: The End of Molasses Classes which become New York Best seller book.

In 2006, Ron Clark founded The Ron Clark Academy, a model school with a vision to transform classrooms around the world by
