CHAPTER I INTRODUCTION

A. Research Background

Nowadays, English becomes the first language that has to be mastered by everyone who wants to communicate globally. It places English as the international language which is used in every field of life, economic, social, politic etc. The point is English is one of many languages that important to be mastered today. Being an international language, English is used in international events and used as the medium of information like science, technology and culture. So, it is not surprise that the teaching of English is carried out in parts of the world. Indonesia for example; treats English as the first foreign language. For the reason above, teachers are forced to be more creative in transforming knowledge, teachers should understand the good way to teach and teachers need to use varieties of teaching technique to make students interest to study about grammar. In this case, the researcher will try to apply a technique use of song lyrics to teach English grammar (Simple Future Tense) in SMP N 31 Semarang. Here, the methods of teaching used by teachers are just giving lecture and text book oriented. Because of this, students tend to be bored and less attention to learning process. In the line of this, this research will help teachers and students to be more enjoyable in English learning process. For example, here the researcher tries to use song lyrics to stimulate the students in English learning process, especially on Simple Future Tense.

So, Teachers must be creative and smart to make interest atmosphere, because it can be influence of learning process. In this case, the researcher uses songs in her research because song or music gives positive effect to stimulate the learners. Music and song are included as teaching media. The use of music and song in the classroom give positive stimulate to learner who learn a language.⁴ A piece of music can change the atmosphere in a classroom or prepare students for new activity; it can amuse and entertain, and make a

The researcher knows about the condition of school and students more than 2 months, because beside the researcher did observation, she ever teaches students of SMPN 31 Semarang when practice learning study 2 years ago. Motivation students are very important problem, the researcher is sure that this method will help students and teachers in learning process in the future. The researcher hopes, this technique will make a significant change for the students and the teacher especially.

B. Reason For Choosing the Topic

The researcher has chosen the topic of improving students' understanding on Simple Future Tense using song lyrics for the following reasons:

F. Definition of Key Term

1. Song lyrics

Song is short piece of music with words that you sing. Song in general is music for singing a song at a very low price song and dance unnecessary fuss.⁶ Teaching by using song is actually very enjoyable because suggestion of song music can make students to relax situation and free from pressure.⁷ Song in foreign language classes maybe use to motivate students and to create a more relaxing foreign language classes.⁸ Lyric is expressing direct personal feelings of or for singing.⁹ The researcher use song lyrics as a media to stimulate students to study English.

2. Improve students understanding

Improve is become or make something better, to increase good qualities.¹⁰ Student is person who is studying at a college or university, any person interested in particular subject.¹¹ In this case, student is object of this research, students as a measure the research. We know this research effective or not, benefit or not it is depend the students. So, cooperating learning is very important to make the grade. Understanding is a psychological process related to an abstract or physical object, such as a person, situation, or message whereby one is able to think about it and use concepts to deal adequately with that object.¹²

3. Simple Future Tense

In grammar, the future tense is a verb form that marks the event described by the verb as not having happened yet, but expected to happen

in the future.¹³ Simple Future Tense is describing the tense which describes a future action: uses forms of *will*, *shall* of *be going to*.¹⁴ The pattern of Simple Future Tense is:

(Subject + auxiliary verb (will/shall/be going to) + main verb)

Will or be going to is used to express future time, the use of shall with I or We to express future time is possible but uncommon in American English. Shall is used much more frequently in British than in American English.¹⁵

4. Classroom Action Research

Classroom action research is a method of describing about what work best in the classroom, so that can improve students' learning. There are many ways to improve knowledge about teaching. The goal of Classroom Action Research is to improve teaching in classroom, department, or school. Classroom action research can do to improve the effectiveness of teaching. While there is no requirement that the findings be generalized to other situations the results can add to knowledge base. Classroom Action Research goes beyond personal reflection to use informal research practices such as a brief literature review, group comparisons, and data collection and analysis.¹⁶
