CHAPTER I INTRODUCTION

A. BACKGROUND OF THE STUDY

Language is a tool of communication among people around the world. By using language, we can express our idea, feeling, thought and interact with others in forms of written and spoken. Without the presence of language, it is hard to imagine how people can cooperate and get along with other. Hence, the presence of language has overcome people's problems to express and share their feeling, idea and knowledge to others.

The existence of language becomes essentials in every aspect possessed by human being. The field such as politics, economic, social and culture are influenced by the presence of language. Moreover, the presence of language is one of the signs of Allah as a creator. As Allah stated in verse ar-Rum 22:

Based curriculum KTSP 2006 the purpose of teaching English in Junior High School is to gain functions in all level. Teachers, in designing their lesson objective, must consider students' need too in order to ease students in mastering English as a target language that is being learned. In teaching speaking, an English teacher has to be a facilitator to students. He or she must try to give good model in teaching speaking. In this case, an English teacher can use any kinds of media to teach speaking in order to make learning activity cheerful and not monotonous.

Media will offer different situations in teaching and learning process by increasing students' interest of the lesson. Media can be used by both teachers and students. It gives more detail information and focuses the student on the material and skill that is being taught. The use of media also allows the students to be involved in teaching and learning process. It gives the teachers

So, be patient. Surely the promise of Allah is true.
